

EXTERNAL WINDOW CLEANING USER GUIDE

GATHER EQUIPMENT

YOU WILL NEED:

- 1 Window cleaning bucket
- 2 5ltr 10% Detergent
- 3 5ltr bottle pump
- 4 Window cleaning t-bar & sleeve
- 5 Stainless Steel channel & rubber
- 6 Connector handle
- 7 Extension pole
- 8 Blue roll



1. FILL BUCKET WITH WARM WATER

Pick a time when the sun isn't falling directly onto the windows. Otherwise, the solution will dry out quickly because the glass will heat and you'll have to repeat the cleaning process.



2. UNSCREW THE CAP ON THE DETERGENT.

- ATTACH THE 5LTR BOTTLE PUMP



3. DOSE 3 X PUMPS (90ML) OF DETERGENT INTO THE BUCKET OF WATER AND MIX






4. USE THE T-BAR AND WASH SLEEVE TO CLEAN LOW LEVEL WINDOWS

Wash down the window from top to bottom. Make sure the windows are soaking wet.





Use the squeegee to scrape the solution off the glass with a fluid motion. You can either squeegee the window from top to bottom or you can use the "S" technique.



6. USE THE BLUE ROLL TO WIPE THE EDGES OF THE WINDOW FRAME SO THERE'S NO WATER DRIPPING

Wipe the blade of the squeegee from time to time to avoid streaks on the glass.



7. FOR HIGH LEVEL WINDOW CLEANING

Attach the t-bar and wash sleeve to the *extendable pole and repeat step 4. Next, attach the stainless steel handle and rubber to the pole and repeat step 5.
